		view of other Lots or roads and never placed on the street.

		other vehicles are subject to strict limitations.
16	6.1	Exterior antennas not expressly permitted by law require PRC approval.
16	6.3	All driveways and roads must be two-shot "chip seal", blacktop, brick
1.5	C 1	paver, or concrete. PRC approval is required prior to any work.
17	6.4	Exterior lights should be minimal and must be fully shielded (point
10.10	(0	downward and not outward or towards the sky).
18-19	6.9	Mailboxes and support structures must be in strict compliance with the
19	6.10	CFE7 approved style, size, shape, and architectural standards.
19	0.10	Play equipment and patio umbrellas are restricted to the enclosed rear yard only.
19	6.12	Roof coating must be tan in color. Contact the PRC prior to any
19	0.12	exterior painting or re-painting.
20-21	6.14	Signs are restricted to only those outlined in paragraph 6.14
23	6.16	No storage tanks may be erected, placed, or buried on any lot.
23	6.17	Fabricated landscape features and landscape art require PRC approval.
